ABOUT HVAR

Eclectic, dynamic and one-of-a-kind, Hvar is a sprawling island where cultures and lifestyles blend only a short distance from breathtaking hills with scattered vineyards, stonewalls and sun-drenched beaches. As well as its unique, celebrity-driven charisma, the surrounding area's natural beauty accounts as much as the city's appeal, with countless cultural and recreational activities along 270 kilometers of coastline.





UNESCO Heritage

Hvar's culture and heritage under UNESCO protection:

Benedictine Nun's Aloe Lace

Aloe lace is made in Croatia only by the Benedictine nuns in the town of Hvar. Thin, white threads are obtained from the core of fresh aloe leaves and woven into a net or other pattern on a cardboard background. The resulting pieces are a symbol of Hvar.

"Following the Cross" Procession

The origins of this unique procession are linked to a period of a peasant revolt against the Venetian governance when, according to legend, a small cross began to bleed before a conflict. It is also interesting to note that in nearly five centuries of celebration, the tradition has never been interrupted. Even in 1944, when the procession was forbidden by the German authorities, refugees from the island of Hvar conducted the procession between their tents in the refugee camp of El Shatt in Africa. This was the only time the annual procession was not conducted on the island.

Stari Grad Plain

One of the remnants of Hvar history is Stari Grad Plain, one of UNESCO's World Heritage sites. This is a cultural landscape that has remained practically intact since it was first colonized by Ionian Greeks from Paros in the 4th century BC. The original agricultural activity of this fertile plain, mainly centering on grapes and olives, has been maintained since Greek times to the present. The site is also a natural reserve. The landscape features ancient stone walls and trims (small stone shelters), and bears testimony to the ancient geometrical system of land division, the chora, which was used by the ancient Greeks, and has remained virtually intact for over 24 centuries.





MUST-SEE

St. Stephen's Cathedral

The present cathedral was under construction for a long time. Plans were drawn up in 1540, but it was only completed in the 18th century when it acquired its present appearance. Funds were raised through a variety of communal taxes, while the Komiža fishermen were required to hand over a third of their catch from their best fishing grounds.

Arsenal Theatre

In 1579, the people of Hvar began to build a grand, new Arsenal on the site of the former 13th century building. Today, it is one of the most imposing structures in the town. It was used as a maintenance and storage building by the Venetian navy when they overwintered in Hvar Harbor. The Arsenal complex belongs to the highest category of protected monuments, is one of the most significant military/naval buildings in the Mediterranean and its theatre is among the oldest communal theaters in Europe.

Spanish Fortress

Towering above all the reveling and the mega-yachts is the Spanish Fortress, built in the early 16th century and it offers spectacular views of the town and islands below. The fortress is not the original, and the 13th century city walls were constructed soon after the islanders requested Venetian protection in 1278, which predicted it by almost 200 years.









Franciscan Monastery

Built in 1465, it was jointly financed by the nobles of Hvar and sea commanders as a testament to the gratitude for many lives saved at sea near Hvar. The local contribution included 1000 gold coins from Antun Lucić and his son, Hanibal Lucić, who is a famous poet that is buried under the main altar. The "Last Supper" painting by Palma the Younger is also worth visiting.

Hora/Ager Phariensis

Nowhere else in the Mediterranean has such a phenomenon been preserved so well with its rectangular plots measuring 1 by 5 stades (about 180 by 900 metres), bordered by drywalls and crisscrossed at regular intervals by pathways. There is also a small airfield for light aircraft where you can book a flight to get an aerial view of the plain.

Hvar Wineries

A visit to some of Hvar's most renowned wineries will give you the opportunity to not only taste some of the best quality wine, but also enable you to grasp the differences in the aromatic smells and tastes. Some vineyards are positioned on steep hills, with grapes absorbing year round sunshine and spectacular views stretching over the horizon.



HVAR BEST BEACHES

Bonj 'les bains'

The historic early 20th century beach club near the renovated Amfora Resort in Hvar offers a Romaninspired sanctuary of spa services, nutritional cuisine, and lounge service for a burgeoning beach scene. Stone columns frame a rooftop lounge area with a central bar pouring tropical cocktails and freshly squeezed juices. The terrace environment offers the closest thing to a St. Tropez-style beach club in Croatia.





Palmižana

Located on the Paklinski Islands just across the bay, this beach is rich in flora and features a beautiful swimming area. The island has provided it with all basic needs and it has a shop, restaurants and popular bars. The main reason many like to come here is the opportunity to party away from the busy island of Hvar.

Mlini Beach

Located on the Paklinski Islands just across the bay, this pebble beach is naturally protected from the wind.

Zaraće beach

Located in the village Zaraće, this beautiful beach provides natural protection from both the wind and the waves.

Dubovica

Located 8 km east of the town of Hvar, this beach is naturally protected from the wind.

Wild cabbage salad

Very healthy and tasty organically grown wild cabbage of which the leaves are fleshier and thicker than those of other cabbage species.

Gregada

Gregada is a typical hvar dish with several kinds of fish and boiled with potatoes.

A traditional dish made of fresh goat's cheese which is fried with sugar.

Rožada

A juicy and thick egg and milk pudding.

Home-made "Prošek"

This is a delicious dessert wine similar to sherry and it is used as a digestive. Good prosek is produced and developed by the passito method where grapes are chilled in a barrel and left to boil until 15-16% vol. is achieved.
