UNESCO HERITAGE



STARI GRAD AGER FIELD

A natural reserve divided in geometric parcels and divided by stone walls dating back to the 4th century BC

KLAPA SINGING

Form of traditional a cappella singing in Dalmatia, Croatia. The word klapa translates as "a group of friends" and traces its roots to littoral church singing.

ONE OF THE OLDEST PUBLIC THEATRES

The Hvar public theatre was built in 1612, and it enabled all citizens regardless of their social status to participate in various cultural events.



TRADITIONAL EASTER PROCESSION

Following the Cross dates back to the 16th century

DRY STONE WALLING

A building method by which structures are constructed from stones without any mortar to bind them together.

ALOE LACE

Made only by Benedictine nuns in the town of Hvar

LAVENDER

Glorified as the island of lavender, with slopes beaming a vibrant purple and a pleasant aromatic scent. Each year is marked with the festival of lavender that brings people together to celebrate one of Hvar's most treasured symbols

BEST PLACES TO VISIT WHEN IN HVAR

FORTRESS ŠPANJOLA

Built in the 16th century under the Venetian rule, it offers exquisite architectural structure and stunning panoramic views of Hvar and its archipelago



BEACH CLUB HVAR

A luxurious beach club, built in 1927 with white stone colonnades settled under pine trees. Since its inception as the first city beach in Hvar, it established itself as the quintessential landmark. Named by the Times as Top 20 beaches in Europe.



SVFTA NFD.IFI.IA

A charming old village, high above the sea, consisting of stone houses carved into steep hillsides.



ST. NICHOLAS PEAK

Spectacular views of islands and mountains at the mainland. Pass through lavender fields, rough terrain and explore the unexplored.

PEBBLE BEACHES

Find an abundance of secluded romantic pebble beaches and coves across the island and the archipelago

BLUE CAVE TOUR

Illuminated by the sun, it displays striking azure colors that transcend throughout the cave



WINERIES

Wine tours are a must on the island, giving the opportunity to taste some of the worlds most renowned wines that stem from the heart of Hvar



ISLAND HOPPING

Serving as the focal point, Hvar enables island hopping to surrounding islands of Korčula, Vis and Brač



HVAR BEST BEACHES

BEACH CLUB HVAR

The historic early 20th century beach club near the renovated Amfora Resort in Hvar offers a Roman-inspired sanctuary of spa services, nutritional cuisine, and lounge service for a burgeoning beach scene. Stone columns frame a rooftop lounge area with a central bar pouring tropical cocktails and freshly squeezed juices. The terrace environment offers the closest thing to a St. Tropez-style beach club in Croatia.







ZARACE BEACH

Located in the village Zaraće, this beautiful beach provides natural protection from both the wind and the waves.



DUBOVICA

Located 8 km east of the town of Hvar, this beach is naturally protected from the wind.



just across the bay, this beach is rich in flora and features a beautiful swimming area. The island has provided it with all basic needs and it has a shop, restaurants and popular bars. The main reason many like to come here is the opportunity to party away from the busy island of Hyar.





MLINI BEACH

Located on the Paklinski Islands just across the bay, this pebble beach is naturally protected from the wind.
